Installed Automatic Doors to The Yomiuri Shimbun's New Head Office Building

Nabtesco has installed 95 automatic doors to The Yomiuri Shimbun Tokyo head office building newly opened on January 6, 2014, as well as 35 automatic door switches for multifunctional toilets installed on all floors of the building.

Founded in 1874, The Yomiuri Shimbun boasts the world's largest annual circulation of 10 million. The new building stands 33 floors above ground (200 meters) and three floors below, serving as a new landmark for Otemachi, the district that forms the heart of the Japanese economy. In a bid to enable the newspaper to continue publication amid devastating disasters, the building meets the highest standards for earthquake resistance and fire prevention.

To create atmosphere of openness in the building's main entrances at first floor, we have installed 11 automatic doors by the use of automatic door engines designed to be embedded in the floor. Generally it is difficult to install the floor embedded door engines without a gap, however, we have made the gap as small as possible this time.

We strive to provide the most advanced automatic doors to the landmark buildings in Japan as well as in the world.
